

A : You don't look so well. You look feverish.

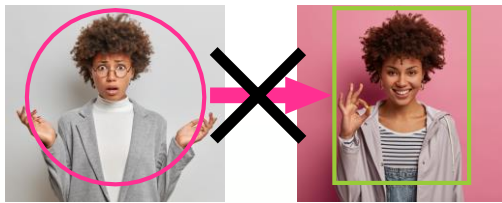
B : I guess I'm all right.

A : I don't think that I can come to work tomorrow.

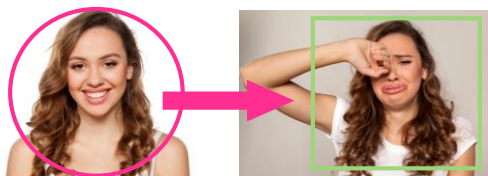
B : Are you serious? We have an important meeting tomorrow.

A : **I know, but a week ago I promised my kids I would () them to an amusement park.** I don't want to disappoint them.



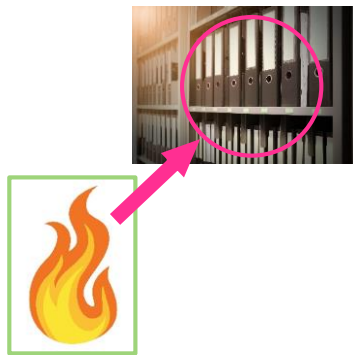
A : The door is jammed and I can't get in.

A : Which necklace would you like to try on?

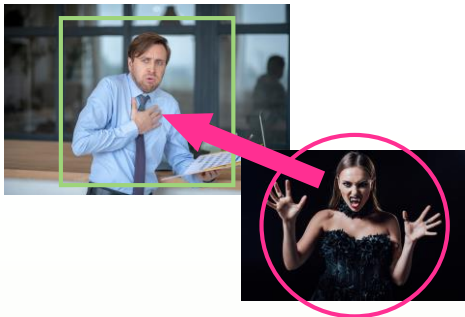
B : **Hmmm, that 24k gold ruby necklace really () my attention.**
