B : Usually March to April is the best. **The warm spring breeze () the cherry blossom into full bloom.**



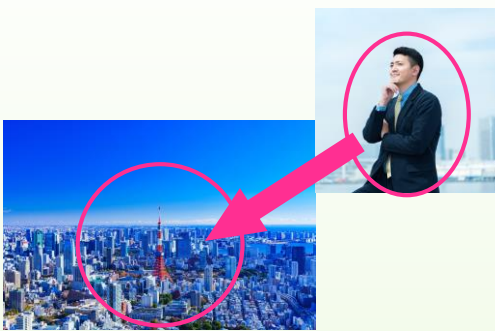

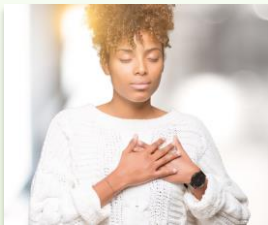

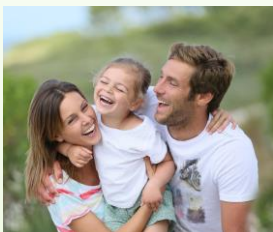
