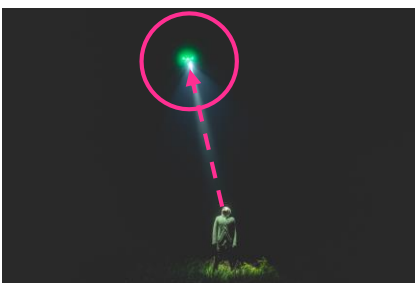




A : How was your last trip to Venice?  
B : The city is amazing. **You don't get to see a river ( ) through the city anywhere else.**



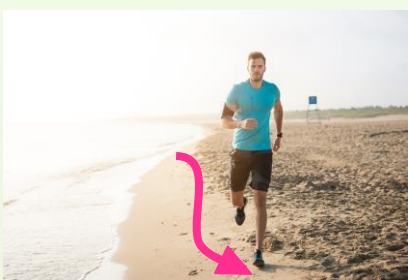
A : ( ) ! A UFO!

A : **You ( ) happy.** Did anything good happen today?

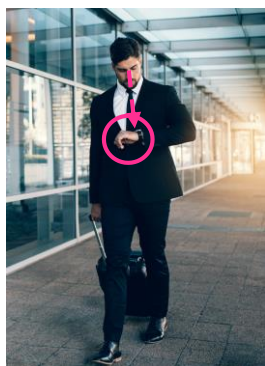
B : Yes! I just got nominated for Forbes 30 Under 30 in Japan.

A : How is your flower shop business?

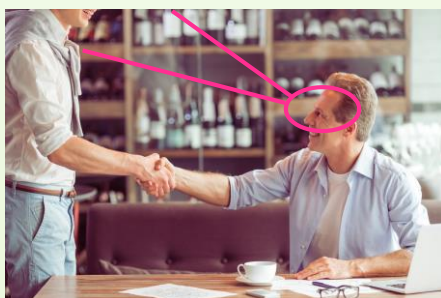
B : **It is ( ) very well.** Valentine is coming up, so I guess there will be a lot of orders coming in.

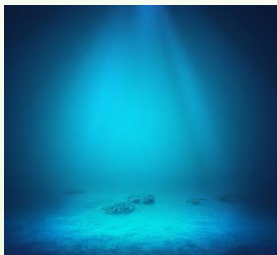

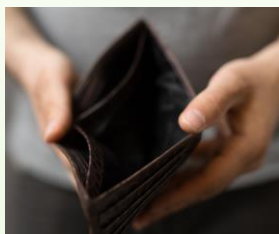

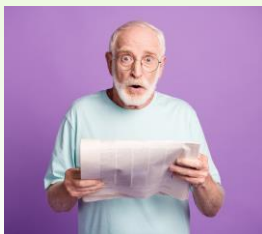
