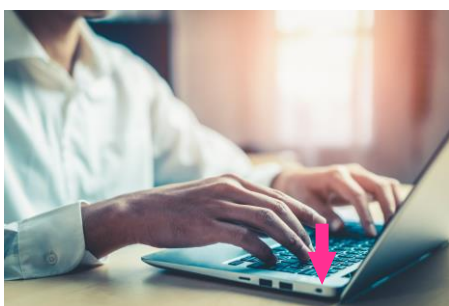




A : **My mother is () me into marriage.** She said that I have to be married before 30, otherwise I would lose my value.

B : Wow, good for him. **His hard work must have () the attention of the boss.**



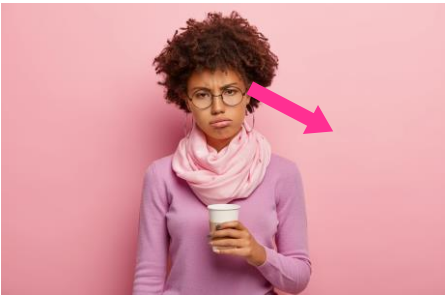
A : Did you make it to Nagano last week? The weather report said there was a huge snow.

A : Wow, your factory's manufactory line looks tremendous.

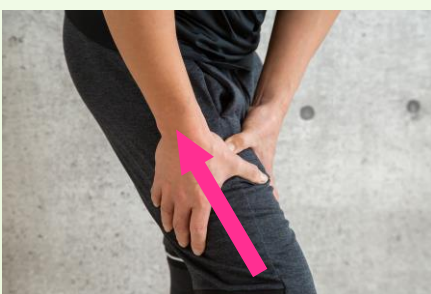
B : Yes, we are very proud of our automatic system. **All you have to do is to () a button.**

Then a big paver () it tight.



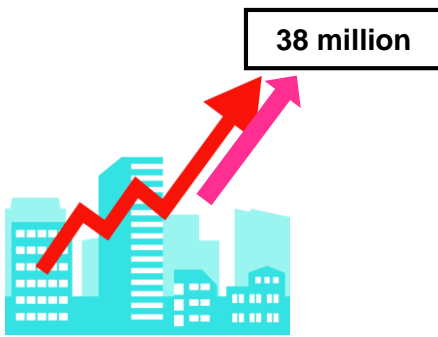
A : I started to jog since last week.

Liverpool was in the lead in the first half. 2 to 1. But in the last 3 minutes, Manchester managed to level the score.



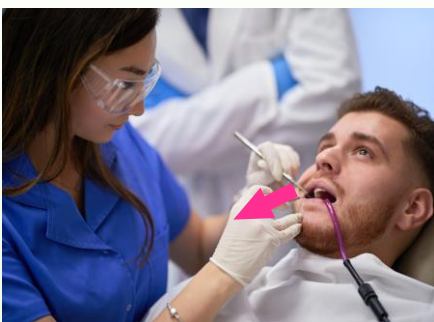
A : I wonder which city is the larger, Shanghai or Tokyo.

A : You look very tired. Are you alright?

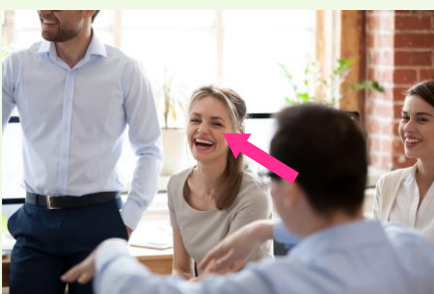
B : **There are too many problems () on my mind and I can't shake them off.**



A : Ouch, my tooth really hurts.

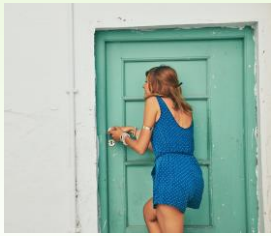
B : Maybe you should go to a dentist.

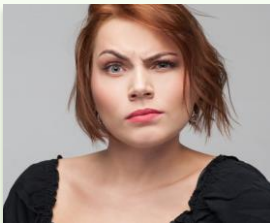

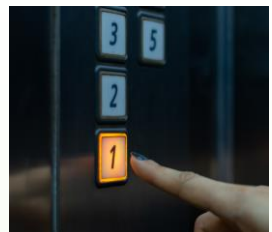
