B : I live () town. It's quite far.

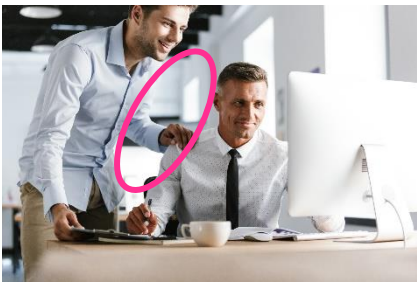
A : It's alright. The last train is gone anyway.

A : Mr. Watanabe fell from the stairs yesterday.

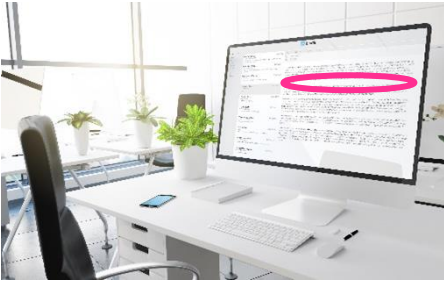
B : Oh my goodness! Is he alright?

B : **I remember there is one () this street.** We are on No.2 street right?



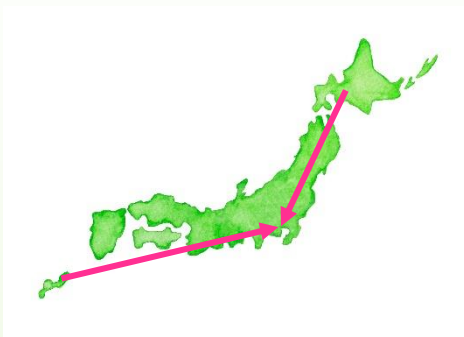
A : Hey, can you check this email for me?

B : **Can you set it () the couch and the TV?**



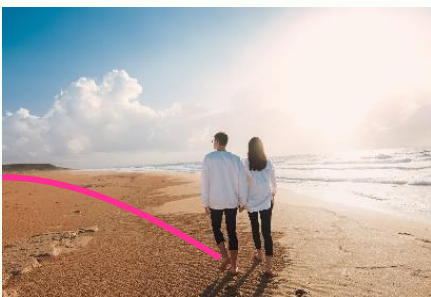
A : You look sharp today.

B : **Well, we go to a nice restaurant and go walking () the beach later with a starry sky upon us.**



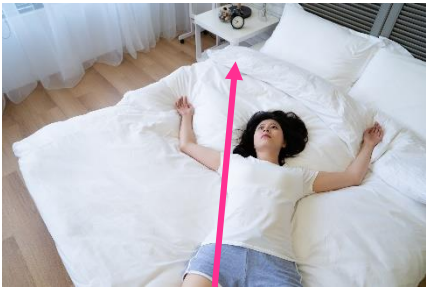
A : I think Elena is like a superwoman.

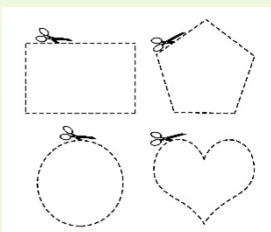
