B : Well... I think you could use more data and graphs. It's a little hard to read with only words.



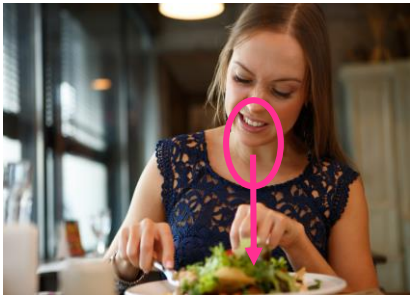
