B : Already? Do we have to leave so soon?

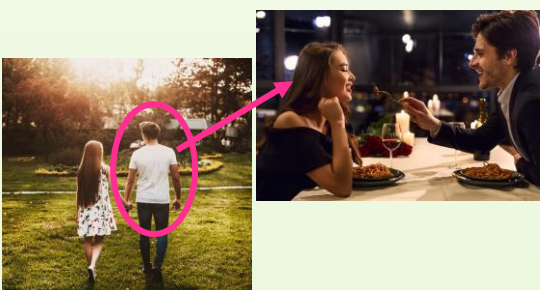
A : Well, it's getting dark. Could you help me () () the tent?

A : How was your interview?

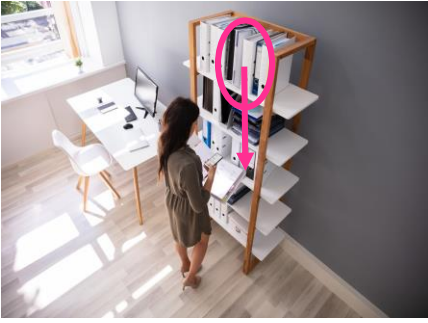

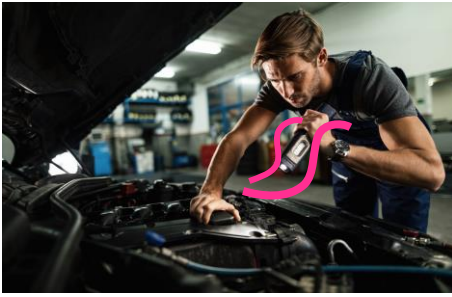
A : It was such a pleasure to have a talk with you in person today. **But I'm sorry to have () () your precious time.**

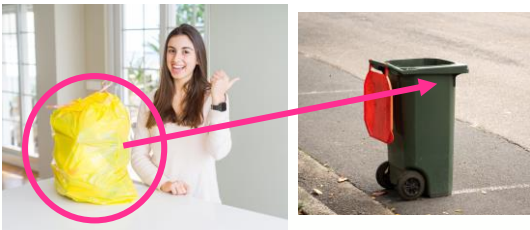
B : Sure. No problem.

A : I have a friend and he just got married recently. **He () () a life insurance policy on his wife right after he got married.**

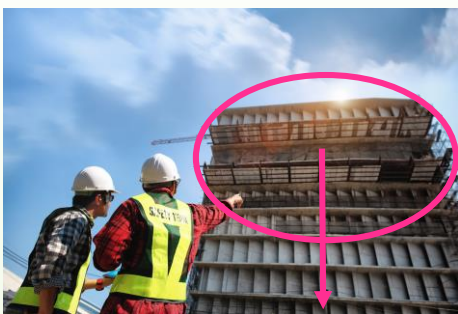
B : Who is the beneficiary?
